The children are thoroughly enjoying their swimming lessons. It is lovely to see all the children learning this essential skill, which is so important for their safety and development.

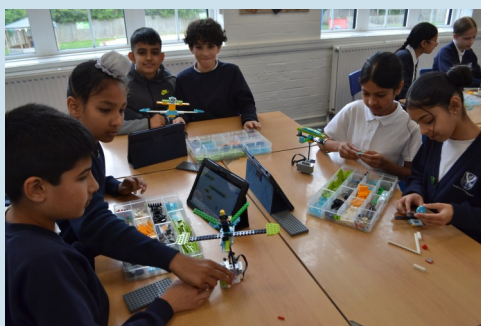


Please remember to send in: swimming costume, towel, and swimming hat on their designated swimming days. This will ensure that they have the best experience possible during their lessons.
