## **Attendance and Communication**

To ensure all children have the opportunity to attend our co-curricular clubs, we have some expectations for our school families around attendance to clubs for pupils.

These are:

- Pupils will be expected to attend every session of any club they sign up to
- Pupils will be allowed to miss no more than 2 sessions of any club. If they do, their club space will be given to another pupil on that club's waiting list
- If a pupil is in school and they do not attend their club the school will contact parents/carers to check the reason for this
- If a pupil is absent from school on the day of a club they attend this will not be counted as a club absence

Club spaces are allocated on a first come, first served basis and are booked via our school Parent Pay system. The maximum amount of spaces in each club varies.

## **Monitoring**

To ensure the effectiveness of our co-curricular offer, clubs will be monitored to ensure the following:

- They are offering pupils the opportunity to develop and practise a variety of skills, including our Character Virtues
- They promote pupil wellbeing and health and manage risk and ensure safety
- They maximise pupil engagement
- They promote inclusivity and the upkeep of our school mission
